I need you. - Potřebuju tě.



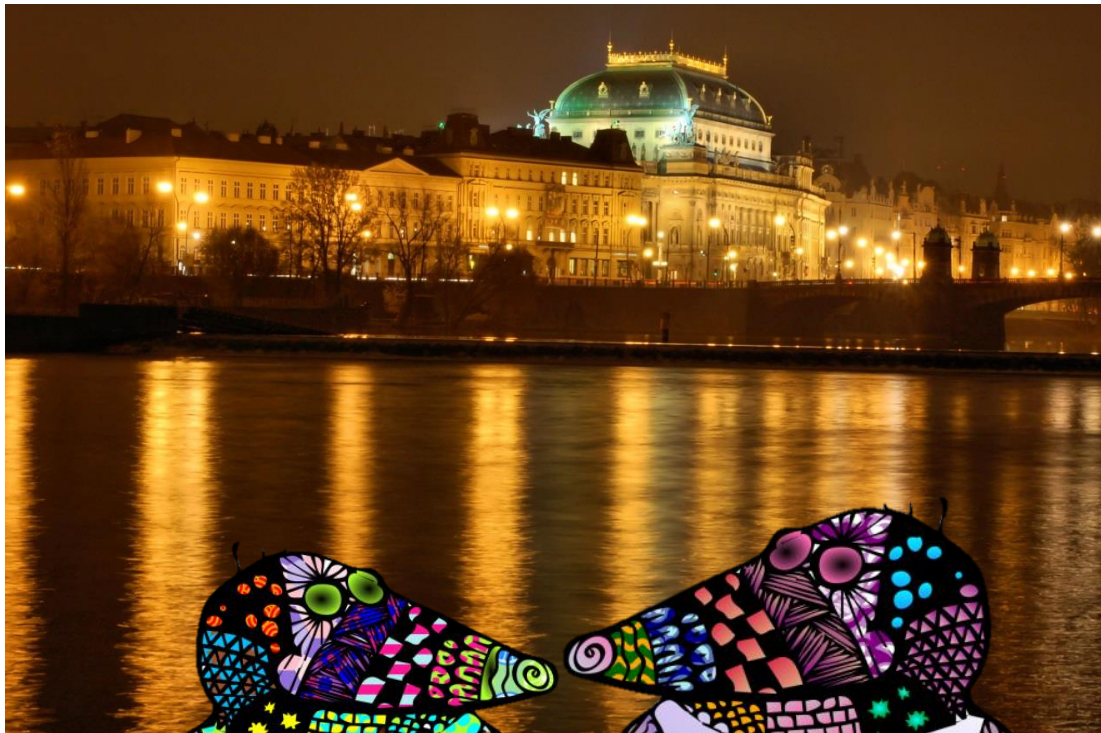
We are happy and we hope we will live happily ever after.

I enjoyed the races and met Soukalová and Moravec. I have a group photo with the team too.

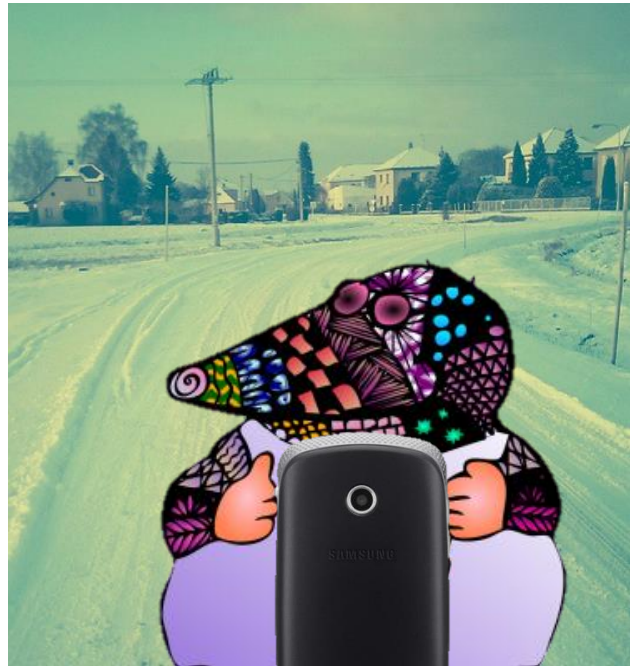


I can ski!

Sněžka Mountain is located in the Krkonoše Mountains.

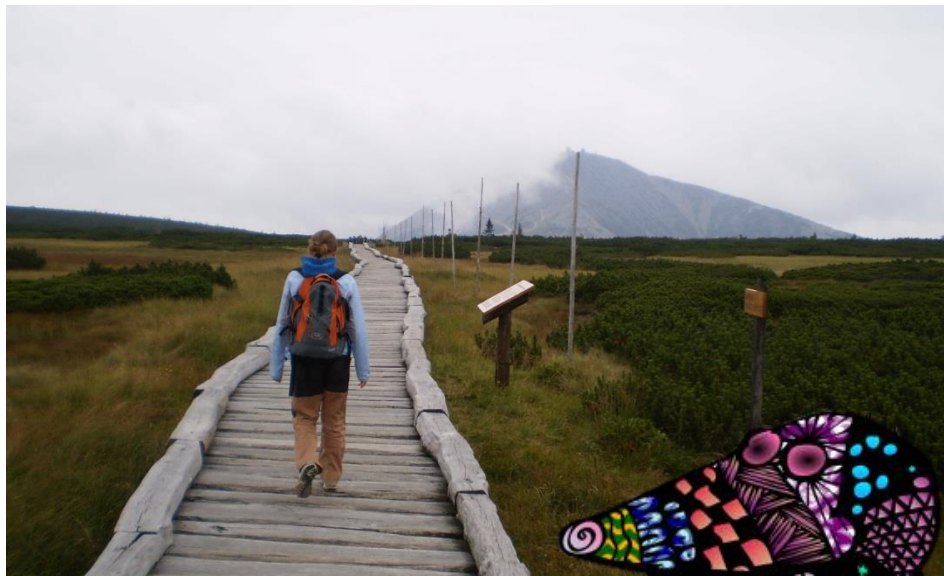
Sněžka, 1,603 meters above sea level, is a popular place for tourists from many countries.

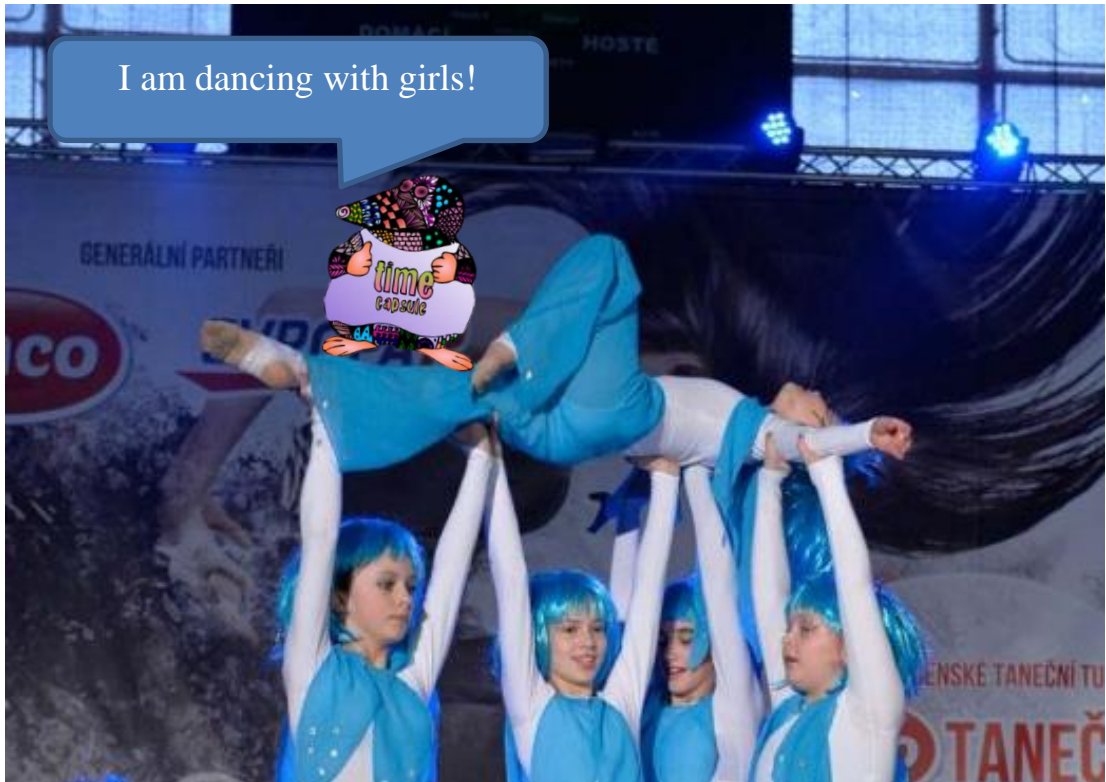

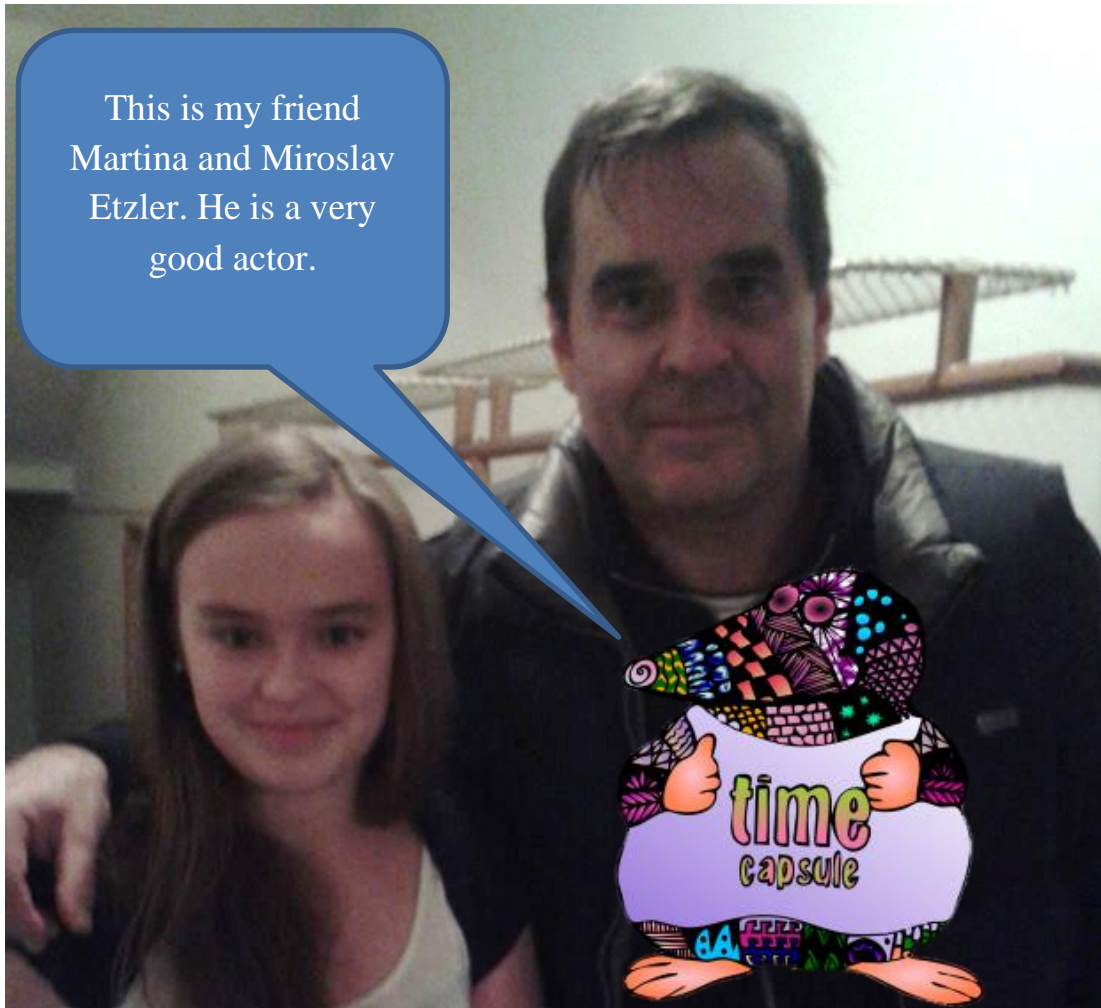

This is a nice castle!



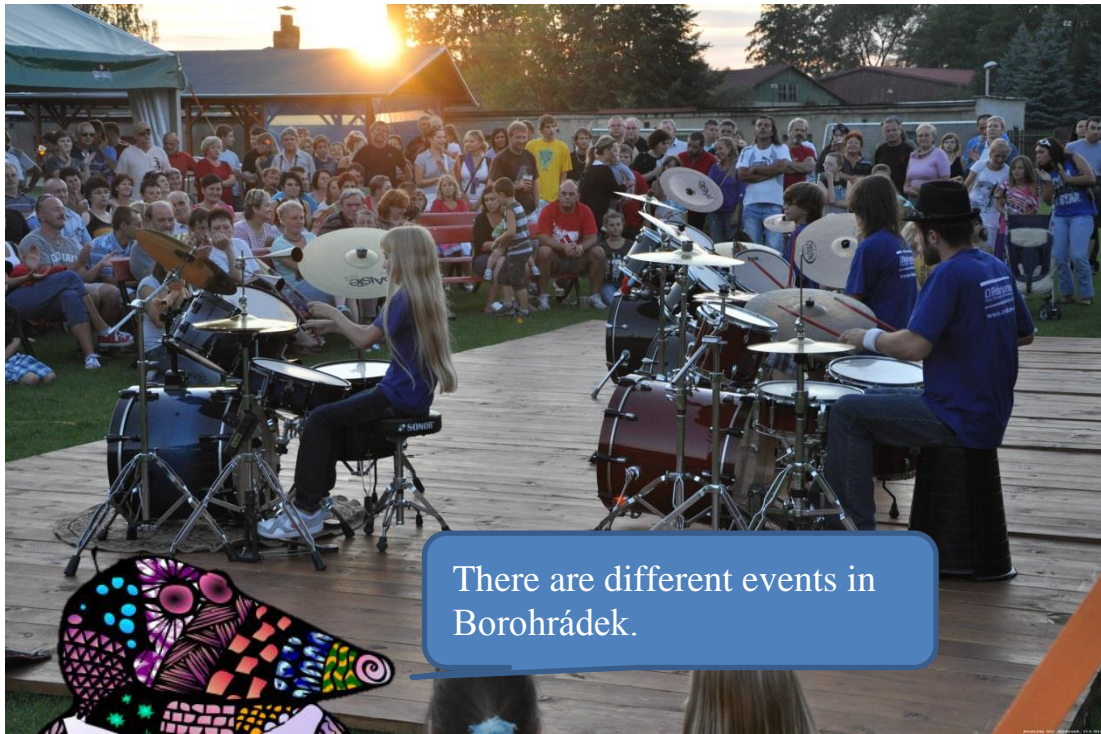

This is the football team from Zdelov. Some of my friends live in Zdelov.



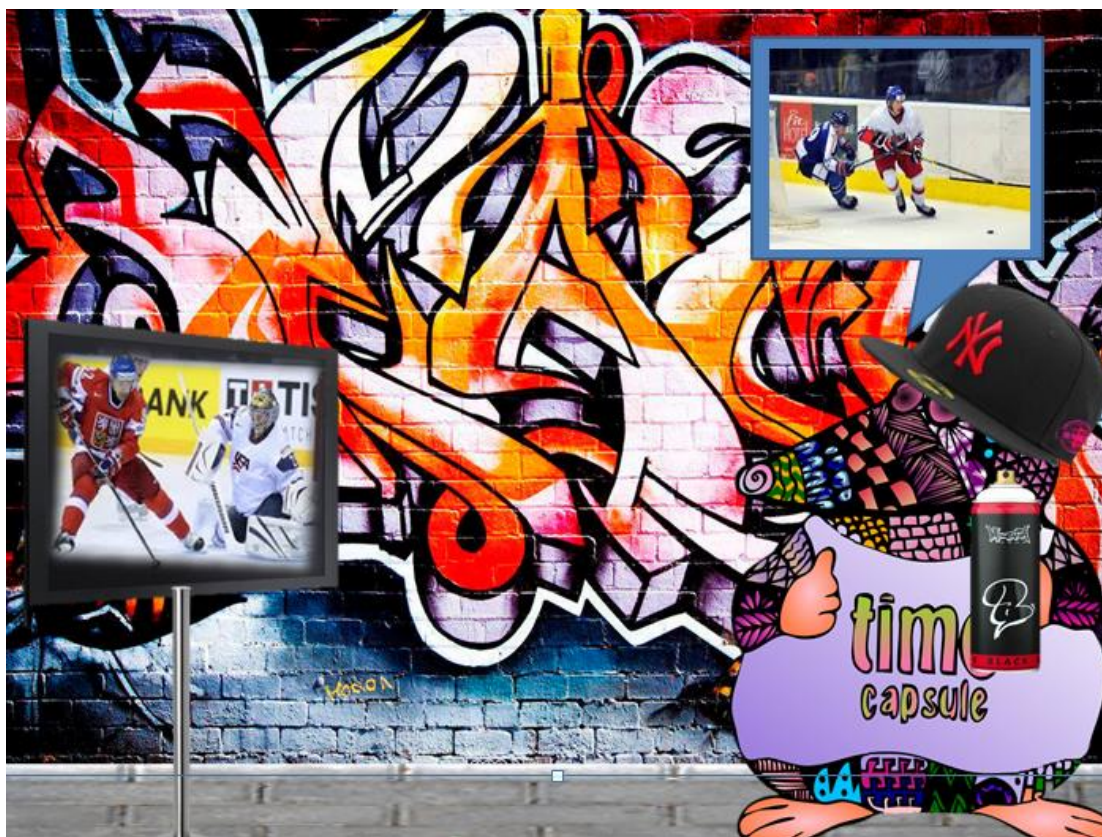

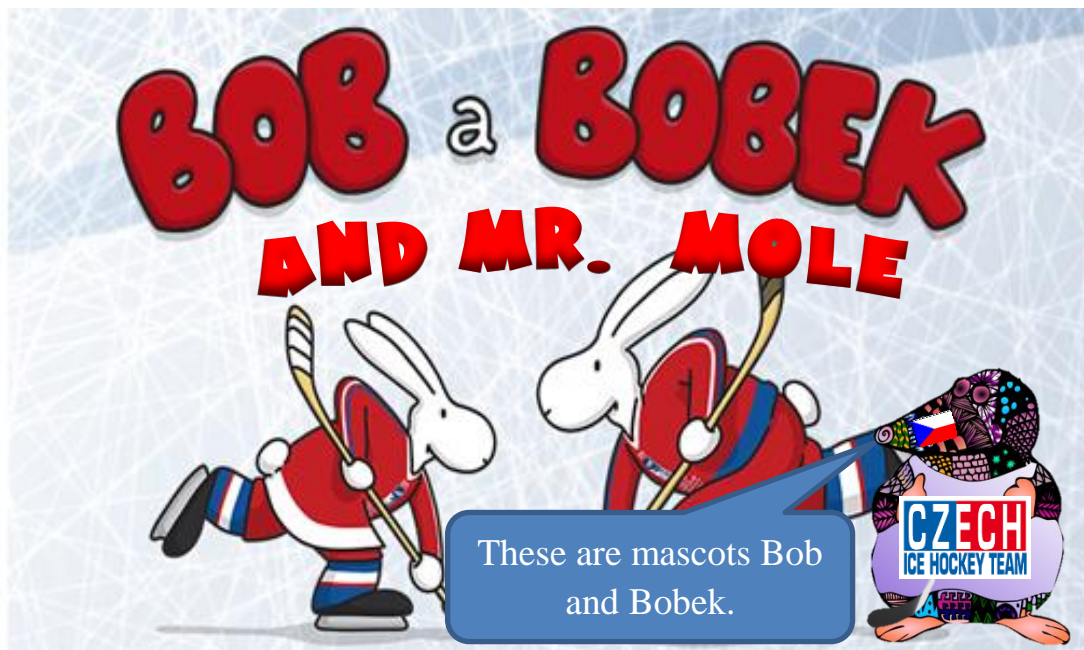
Ice hockey fever

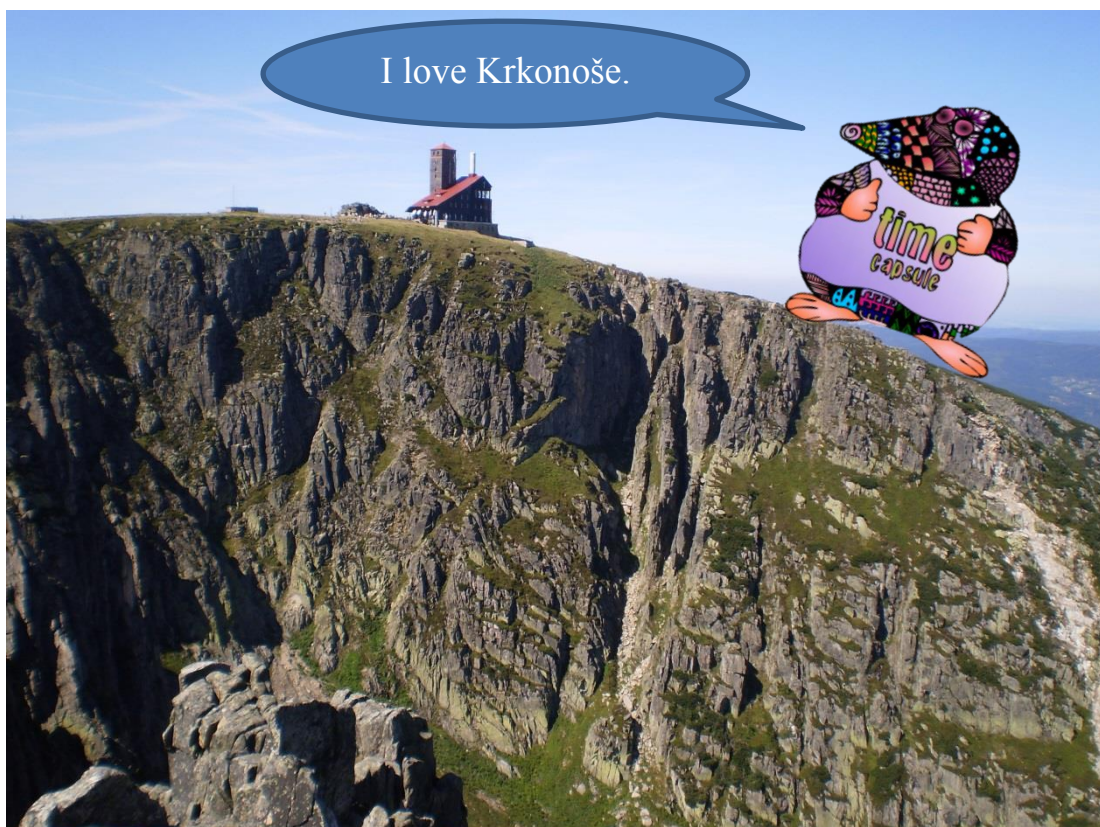

Then I travelled and visited different places and met famous people from this country.



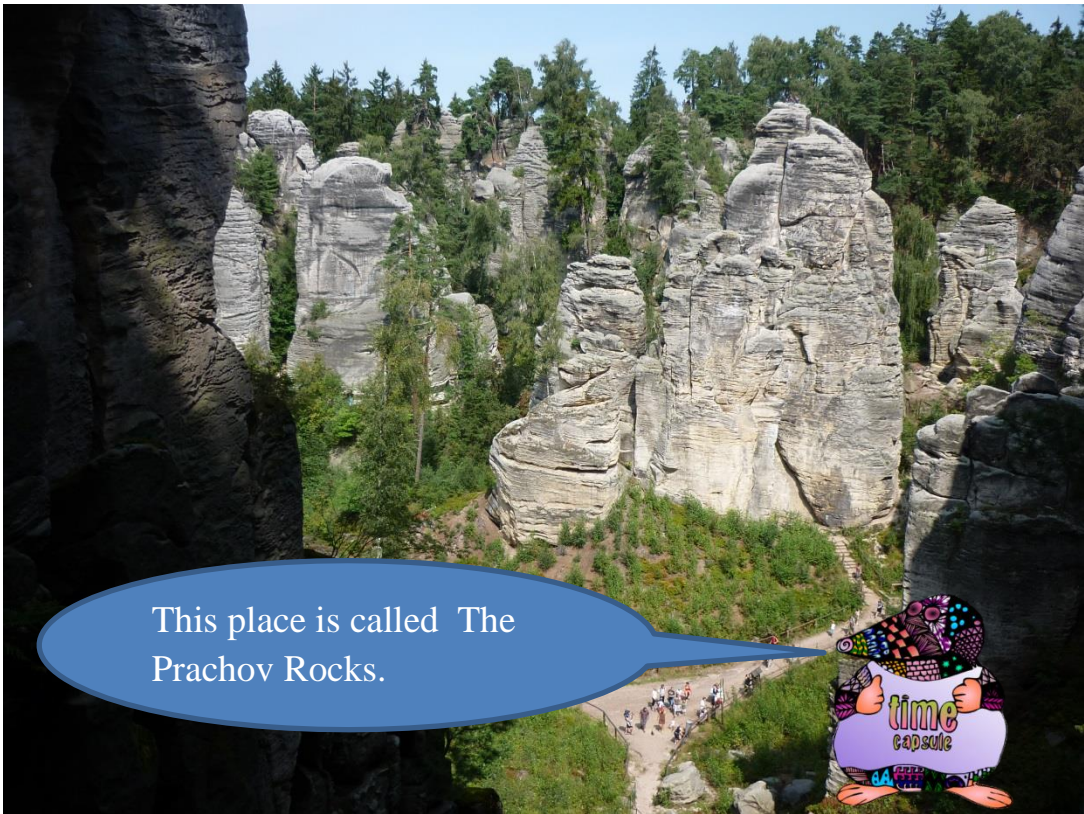

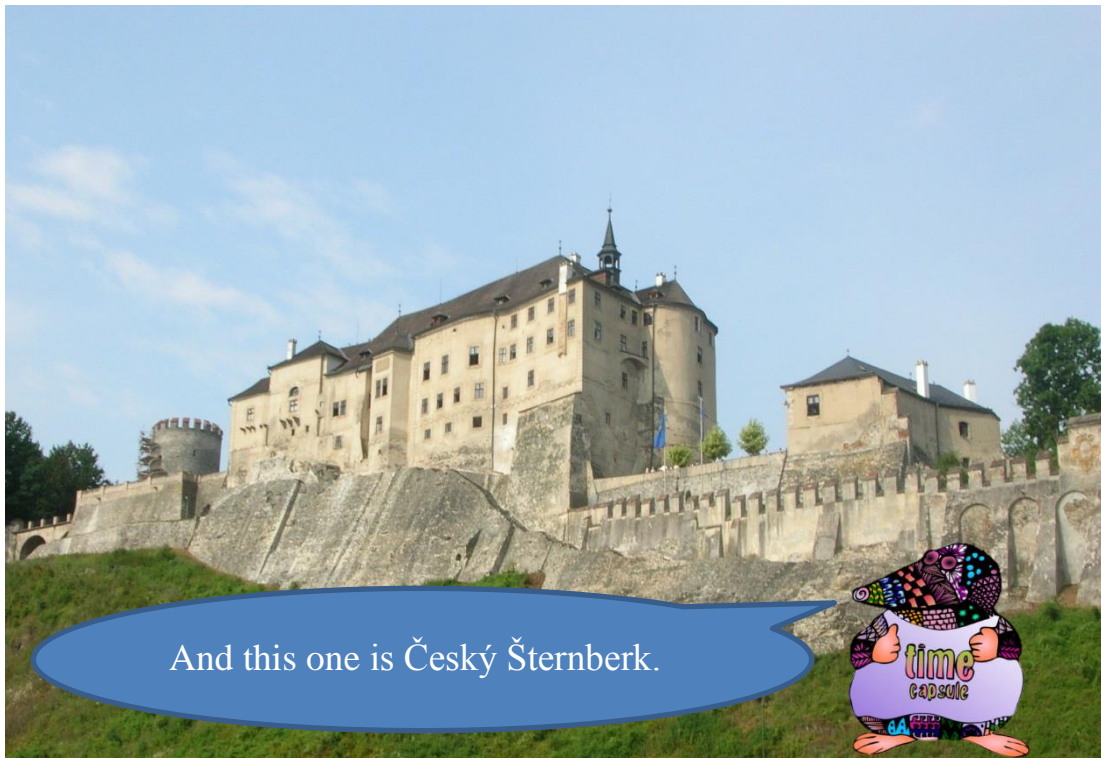








This is Potštejn.

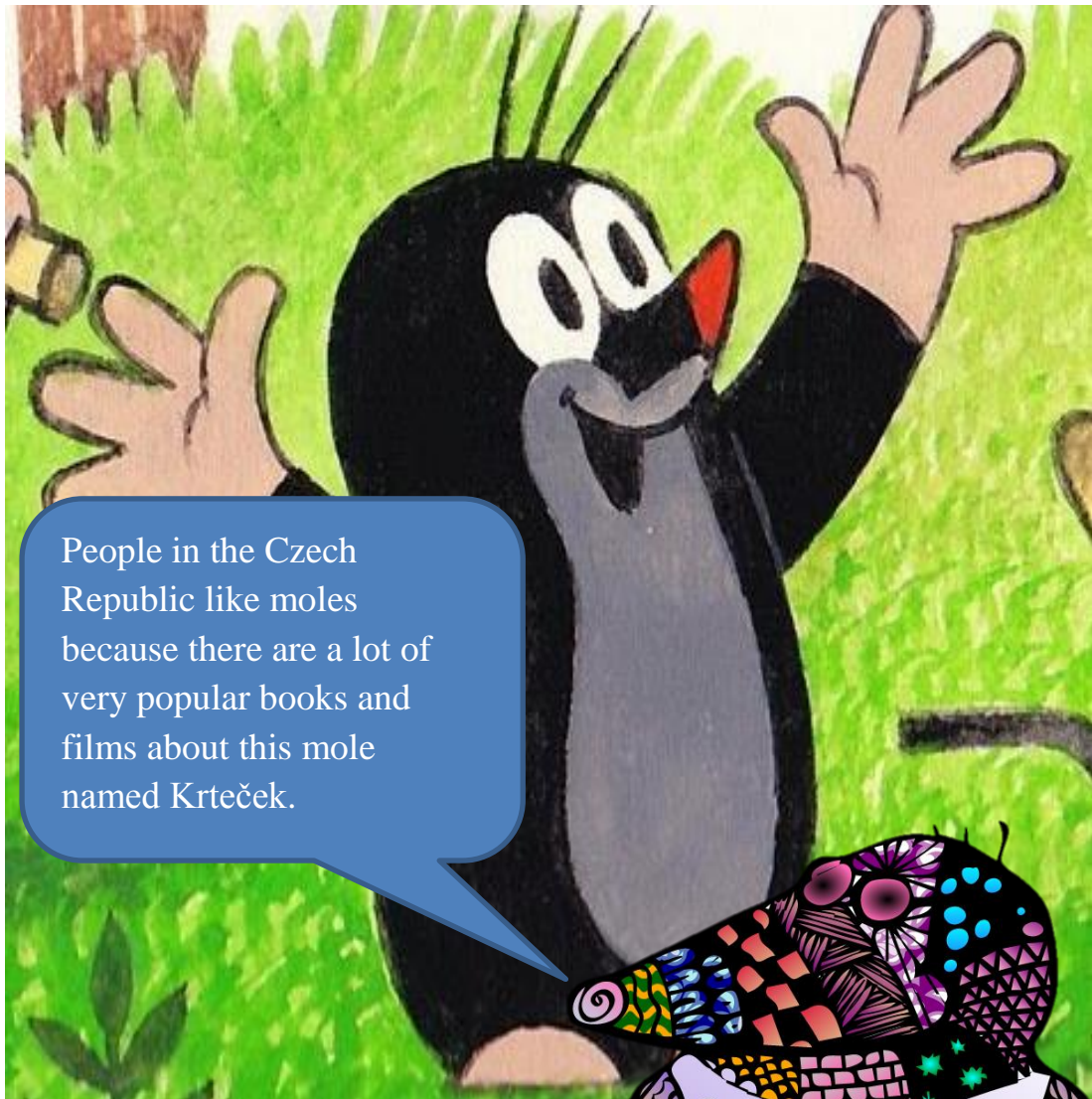




I watched a musical Carmen. It was great. And this is Lucie Bílá – a popular Czech singer.
